

Estate Vineyard

Terraced on a hillside, our estate Syrah vineyard sits at 1,100 ft. elevation in the southern Mayacamas Mountains near the Napa-Sonoma county line. Warm, sunny days and evenings cooled by coastal fog provide ideal conditions to ripen the fruit while maintaining the flavor profile of grapes grown in a cooler climate. The soil is rocky and low in nutrients, naturally reducing the yield to around 3 tons per acre.
